Ohio's Tiered Quality Rating & Improvement System

Washington-Nile Local School District's Early Childhood Center (Preschool Program) is a **5 STAR Quality Rated** Program. The Early Childhood Center provides a strong foundation for young children preparing to enter kindergarten. Children explore, through developmentally appropriate play - with Ohio's new *Birth – Kindergarten Entry Early Learning and Development Standards* as the focal point for each child's growth and development. Head Preschool teachers (Amy Berry and Alisha Adkins) are highly qualified professionals with bachelor's degrees in the field of early childhood education. These teachers work in close collaboration with our Head Start Teachers.

NEW for School Year 2016-17: Preschool children must be 4 years of age by September 30, must not be eligible for kindergarten, meet all eligibility guidelines, and must be potty trained. Washington-Nile Schools provides transportation to/from children's homes to PWES on the elementary bus routes/times. Preschool is scheduled for **Monday – Thursday** each week.

Parents interested in preschool for their child(ren) are encouraged to contact or stop by Portsmouth West Elementary School (858-1116) or check out our PS website online at <http://www.westsenators.org/preschool>. Families are asked to complete a 1-page "Interest Survey" to let school staff know that you are interested in the program. Preschool spots are filled based on state guidelines/criteria: income, family needs and each child's age. If a child qualifies for a spot in the Preschool Program, parents will then be directed to complete registration paperwork and complete a physical and dental exam.
